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## Attainable Housing Density Incentive Town Halls



The first of two town hall meetings were held on 1/19 for residents to learn more about density bonus increases to incentivize more affordable housing in the downtown developments. A large crowd attended the two-hour event, with many questions asked after a presentation by city staff, led by Director of Planning Steve Cover.

A DSCA ad hoc Zoning and Affordable Housing Committee met with City Planning staff in advance of the 1/19 meeting to provide comments and, a subsequent meeting is planned during mid-February. Representatives from eight different downtown condos are participating in the DSCA committee. Planning staff will be holding a second Town Hall meeting on March 1st at which time proposals for consideration by the community and City Commission are to be unveiled. ## Arts and Cultural

The City Commission is in the process of addressing two significant issues related to the planning for a potential new Sarasota Performing Arts Center.

- Earlier this month the commission unanimously approved plans to enter an agreement with an expert consultant to provide consultation services to the city during the early concept and planning stages for a new performing arts center.
- Further the city commission will be holding a special workshop on 1/30 to further consider the agreed establishment of a Blue-Ribbon committee to determine viable alternatives for sustaining the Van Wezel Center.

## Gulfstream Roundabout Update

As the functional portions of the roundabout are completed, landscaping in the surrounding area is going to be installed. Budgets for this work have been approved and landscape designs are being finalized.

Members of the DSCA Greenspace Committee engaged with the FDOT on design concepts last July. DSCA is pleased to see several recommendations it made were taken to heart in the final landscape plans evolved. Recognition is also due to Parks & Recreation General Manager Candie Pedersen and Senior Planner, Office of Public Arts, Mary Davis Wallace for their work with FDOT that resulted in many more canopy trees and Florida native plants in the landscaping plan than the original treatment.



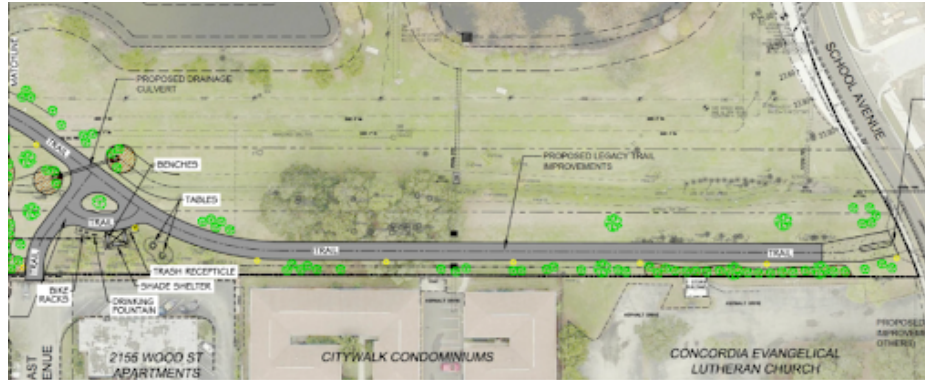
### SRQ Airport

More than 3.8 million passengers traveled through Sarasota Bradenton International Airport last year, a new record for the airport. Last month 377,775 passengers traveled through the Sarasota Bradenton International Airport, compared to 347,268 passengers in December 2021. This represents an increase of 8.8%. Passengers traveling through the airport in the calendar year 2022 totaled 3,847,606. This is a 21.6% increase over the previous calendar year record of 3,163,543 passengers.

## Legacy Trail Extension to Alderman

Great news! The City received confirmation that they received a grant from FDEP totaling \$400,000 for the Legacy Trail – Payne Park connector to the Alderman Multi-Use Recreational Trail (MURT). The total project cost is estimated to be \$775,000. The project concepts are below.

The City Parks & Recreation Department has plans for a bike-ped connector path continuing the path from the south spur ending at School Ave, across the south edge of the park towards Alderman St (behind Sarasota Ford), with an entrance off East Ave (at the breezeblock wall). Also, eventually, plans may be in the works for a northern extension from Fruitville all the way to University Parkway.

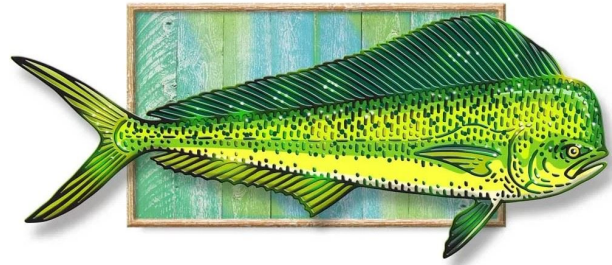

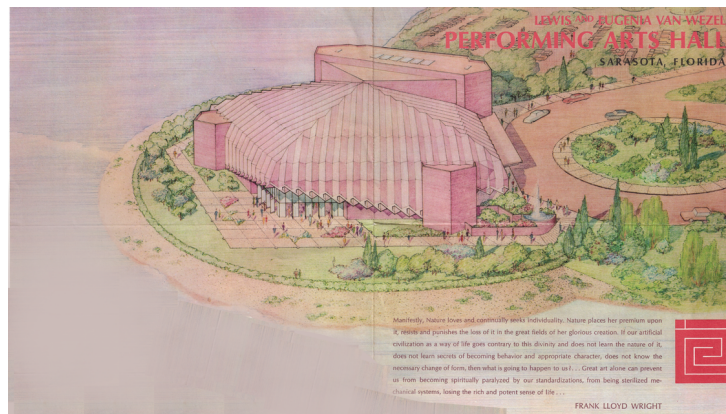
